PUBLIC NOTICE RE WATER RESTRICTIONS

The West Coast has been classified a drought disaster area by the national government in terms of the Disaster Management Act 57 of 2002, which requires extraordinary measures to be taken in respect of this disaster.

As from 15 February 2016 the following stricter Level 2 (20%) water restrictions are effective in the Swartland municipal area:

- The watering/irrigation (with drinking water derived from the municipal potable water mains) of gardens, flower beds, sports fields, parks, lawns and other open spaces is prohibited;
- The filling of swimming pools is prohibited;
- The use of hose-pipes, e.g. to hose down hard-surfaced or paved areas and to wash vehicles (including recreational vehicles and watercraft) is prohibited.
- All automatic-flushing urinals must be turned off in all buildings during times when such buildings are normally vacated by the public and/or staff.

The above restrictions shall not apply (1) where written permission or special exemptions have been granted in writing by the Municipality, or (2) where other sources of non-potable water are used and a notice indicating the source is erected in a position clearly visible from a public thoroughfare.
